You've been affected by crime and now your police department may offer you a restorative justice option. What does that mean? ...And what's next?

Restorative justice is a way of looking at harm that meets victim needs and asks those responsible for the harm to make repair. The confidential process is voluntary and also involves the support of family, community members, and police.
